TEMPORARY
RESTRAINING ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on before the undersigned Superior Court Judge on the Plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 75-11 and Rule 65 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure. It appears to the Court from the complaint and affidavits filed herein that there is good and sufficient cause to believe that the defendants are engaged in unfair and deceptive commercial practices in violation of N.C.G.S. § 75-1.1.

It further appears to the Court that immediate and continuing loss to the consuming public will occur unless defendants are temporarily enjoined from violations of the law, and the Court therefore finds the plaintiff is entitled to a temporary restraining order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that defendants, their trustees, agents, officers, employees, and persons acting in concert with them are temporarily restrained from:

- (a) Preparing deeds for filing on the public record in North Carolina unless each defendant has one or more valid legal documents to demonstrate that he or she, alone or in connection with others, has paid fair market value for the real property to be transferred and has a valid legal claim to the property set out in documents legally filed on the public record;
- (b) Filing deeds on the public record in North Carolina unless each defendant has valid legal documents to demonstrate that he or she, alone or in connection with others, has paid fair market value for the property and has a valid legal claim to the property in documents legally filed on the public record;
- (c) Preparing and filing on the public record in North Carolina common law liens on real property in North Carolina that have no basis in law or fact;
- (d) Preparing deeds purporting to transfer real property if defendants are not either licensed to practice law in the State of North Carolina or have a valid ownership interest in the property;
- (e) In connection with property to which they do not hold legal title, preparing and filing on the public record in North Carolina no trespass notices and other notices of warning about entry onto the property;
- (f) Attempting to take possession of a home by means of filing on the public record in North Carolina a deed that has no basis in law; and
- (g) Destroying, removing, transferring, erasing, or otherwise disposing of any business or financial records, relating to defendants' claim of title to properties in North Carolina.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT at least three days prior to the preliminary injunction

hearing or, to the extent no preliminary injunction hearing is conducted, no later than ten days after the entry of this temporary restraining order, defendants shall provide plaintiff with:

- (a) a list that identifies the names of all of the trusts for which they serve, have served, or have signed as trustee;
- (b) a list of all trusts individual defendants have established in North Carolina; and
- (c) a list of all of the properties in North Carolina where either defendants or any trust identified in (a) and (b) above have filed a deed claiming transfer of ownership of the property, a common law lien, or a notice of any kind.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this matter be heard before the Superior Court Judge presiding at the Wake County Courthouse, Courtroom 10C on August 19, 2011, at 9:30 A. M. on the Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction.


